THE STORY SO FAR ...

The Victoria & Albert Halls complex was built in the latter part of the 19th century and has for many years been a community hub. The Albert Hall opened in 1875, the Victoria Hall following in 1895. A Trust was established to manage the buildings on behalf of the community up until 1984 by which time the Victoria and Albert Halls Development Association had been set up to manage the property and to carry out much needed improvements. Following extensive refurbishment the building was re-opened by Her Majesty the Queen in 1987.

In 2012 the Trust and the Association were incorporated into one body, a SCIO (Scottish Incorporated Charitable Organisation) called the Victoria & Albert Halls (Ballater) Trust – SCO43209, which combines ownership and accountable management. New legislation and the expectations of modern users have made it imperative that further and much more extensive refurbishment be carried out.

In 2014 the Trust successfully completed the double glazing of the windows in the Albert Hall. This project was fully supported by the residents of Ballater who collectively funded the entire cost of this important improvement to that Hall.

Following consultations to establish the needs of the community and various studies of the complex and its structure, reconfiguration of the space to provide better kitchen and toilet facilities for the Albert Hall was completed. The result has been to create a much improved facility, with a community suite within the Albert Hall.

The Trust is now at the stage of improving the heating system, reconfiguring the vacated Library space and constructing toilets for the Victoria Hall on the ground floor. Further work is required to return the granite façade and windows at the Library to their original profile and replace and upgrade the disabled ramps and railings.

The Trust intends to work its way through each stage of the refurbishment programme as funds become available, ensuring that the Halls continue to provide a sustainable community base for all ages, abilities and needs. It is intended to make the V&A Halls a venue of choice for meetings, conferences, exhibitions and celebratory events in a beautiful, peaceful and historic location. Funding for this programme is being sought at various stages from agencies, charities, private and public entities and individuals. Recently, a state of the art commercial WiFi system has been funded and installed to facilitate a broader range of use.

The Trust is about to tackle the heating system for the entire Halls complex and replace this with modern, energy efficient infrared heating.
